- **Letter of nomination from Head of Department / Unit**

All application documents should be merged into **one pdf document** (named with this format "**FullName_MaCall_McBainApplication_2024**") and submitted to the email ipo@knust.edu.gh with the **email subject** as **MaCall_McBainApplication_2024**.

- Only **2022 KNUST graduates** are eligible to apply and should be nominated by the IPO before further online application.
